SUMMARY OF U.S. SENATE/ILLINOIS CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION RESULTS

- One of our two U.S. Senate seats was up- incumbent Mark Kirk as noted above **LOST**

Pre-election split:	1 Democrat / 1 Republican
Post-election split:	2 Democrats / 0 Republican
- All 18 Congressional seats were up in 2016

Pre-election split:	10 Democrats / 8 Republicans
Post-election split:	11 Democrats / 7 Republicans

Bold= winner

CAPS=incumbent

- 1 incumbent U.S. Congressman **LOST** (Dold lost to Schneider in a rematch from 2014)
- The NAR RPAC Trustees conducted **5** Opportunity Races in these federal races—
A LEVEL THREE for **U.S. Senator Mark Kirk**; ; a top tiered LEVEL ONE for incumbent **Robert Dold (R-10th)**, and LEVEL THREE races for incumbents **Bill Foster (D-11th)**, **Cheri Bustos (D-17)** and **Raja Krishnamoorti (D)** in the **OPEn 8th Seat**
- **3 WON and 2 LOST - 60% SUCCESS RATE**

SUMMARY OF THE ILLINOIS GENERAL ASSEMBLY RESULTS

16 OPPORTUNITY RACES - 13 OF 16 WON (81% SUCCESS)

12 IE RACES- 9 OF 12 WON (75% SUCCESS)

- All 118 seats were up in the 2016 general election.
- There were **70** SAFE districts where the seat was UNCONTESTED. This represents **59%** of the races.
- **5 INCUMBENTS LOST THEIR SEATS- 4 D / 1 R**
Pre-election split: 71 Democrats / 47 Republicans (DEM. SUPER MAJORITY)
Post-election split: 67 Democrats / 51 Republicans
- There were **13 OPEN SEATS** (2 APPOINTED MEMBERS INCLUDED)

Post-election split: 37 Democrats/ 22 Republicans (DEM. SUPER MAJORITY)
