





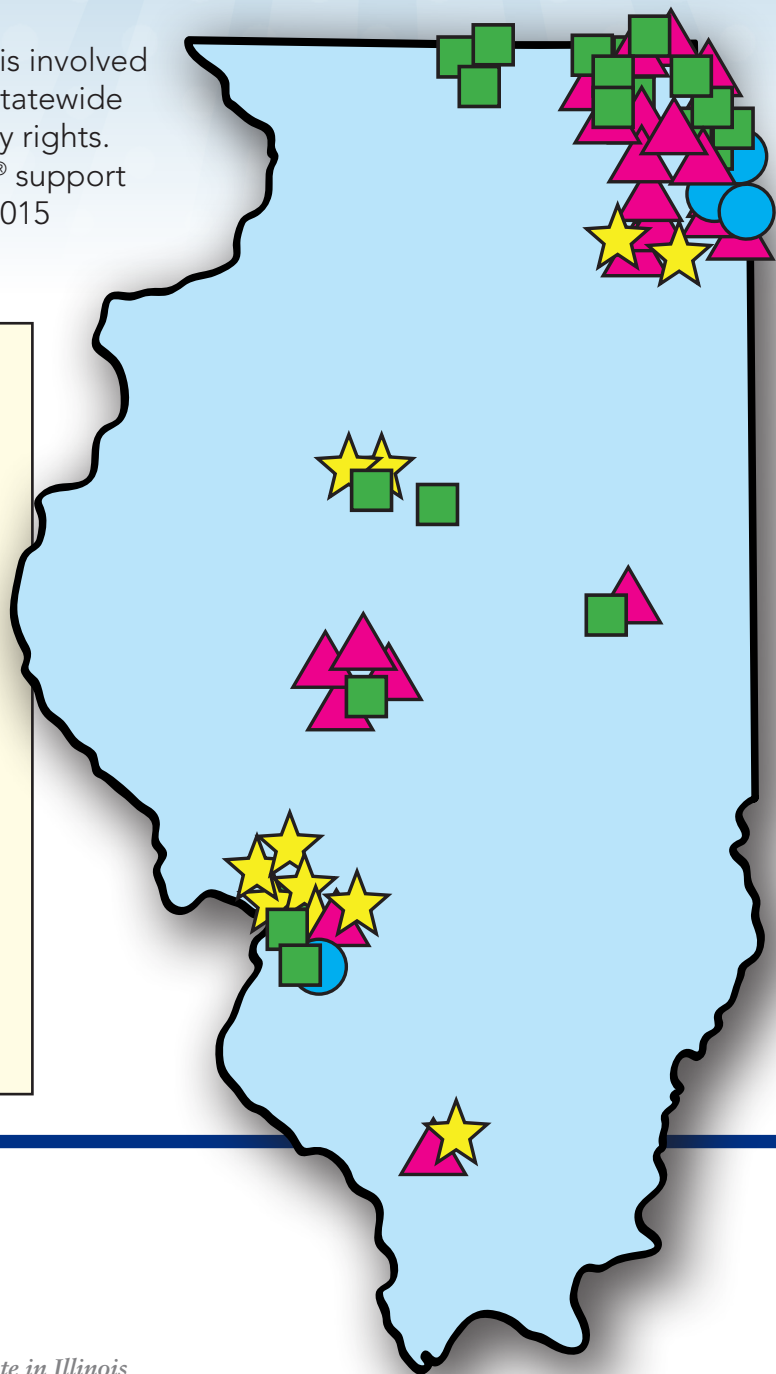

The Illinois Association of REALTORS® is involved in political races and ballot referenda statewide that have an impact on private property rights. Here's a look at races where REALTOR® support played an important role in the April, 2015 elections.

-  **RPAC "Opportunity Races"**
Candidates in these races are strong on REALTOR® issues, including private property rights.
-  **IAR Fund (Independent Expenditures)**
An IAR political fund plays a role in supporting candidates, but does not coordinate with them.
-  **Local Referenda**
IAR backs or urges defeat of ballot initiatives that have a bearing on private property rights.
-  **RPAC Support**
IAR's political action committee makes direct contributions to candidates seen as strong on REALTOR® issues.
